This month we highlight IPD cylinder liner packaging. Since having an ***induction-heat-treated*** cylinder liner was one of our first unique products at IPD many years ago, it seems only right to again begin with the centerpiece of our product line. This time, it is the care we take to package our liner. You may have already begun to see this new packaging on many of our liners and more are in process of being integrated into stock.

**IPD 2W6000/CS liner
with protective IPD top and bottom caps**

Some features include:

- Ultrasonic cleaning at the factory as a last step before packaging to remove any machining residue that made it through production
- Temporary rust-prohibitive to assure proper shelf life.
- Heavy-duty sealed plastic bag to keep dirt out.
- IPD top and bottom caps to prevent flange and bottom surface nicking and to again seal out dirt. We also may include Styrofoam on top and / or bottom.
- Heavy gauge IPD logo box for attractive presentation.

Why bother?

Because we feel strongly that going the extra steps help assure that the engine owners feels he has received the highest level of quality in the IPD package. and performance.
